- 1) The Project Engineer cum Estate Officer on behalf of the Director IISER, Pune invites sealed item rates tenders from approved and eligible registered contractors of CPWD, State PWD & MES, for the work mentioned below and who are eligible as per the eligibility criteria defined below.
- 2) **Name of the work:** "Construction of RCC Storm water drain ,service ducts , Road, entrance gate & security cabin at IISER Pune"

- 4) Blank tender documents consisting of specifications, the schedule of quantities of the work to be executed and the set of terms and conditions can be obtained from the office of the Project Engineer cum Estate Officer , Indian Institute of Science Education and Research 900,NCL Innovation Park, Dr. Homi Bhabha Road,Pune 411008 (Maharashtra), between 11.00 hrs and 16.00 hrs. w.e.f . **11-04-2011 to 19-04-2011** on all working days (except Saturdays, Sundays / Public Holidays)on payment of Rs. 5000/- (Rs. Five thousand only) (Cost of tender documents -non-refundable) in the form of demand draft / pay order drawn in favour of Director , Indian Institute of Science Education and Research Pune payable at Pune .
- 5) **Eligibility criteria:** Tenders forms will be issued to approved and eligible registered contractors of CPWD, State PWD & MES subjected to followings eligibility conditions.

5.1) On production of the definite Proof of valid contractor license/ enlistment certificate with the CPWD, State PWD & MES, issued by the respective enlistment authority of the concerned department for the amount not less than estimated value of the work.

5.2) The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of sale of tenders.

5.3) In case only the last date of sale of tender is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of sale of tenders. In case both the last date of receipt of application and sale of tenders are extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on either of the two date's i.e. original date of sale of tender or on the extended date of sale of tenders.

5.4) Proof of latest submission of Income Tax returns for the current financial year as on 31/03/2010 PAN/TAN NO.

5.5) Should have satisfactorily completed 3 similar works each costing Rs 2.00 crore or completed two similar works each costing Rs 2.50 crore or completed one similar work costing Rs 4.00 crore, during the last seven years ending 31st March 2011.

Similar works mean the RCC building work or development civil works having RCC structures like RCC storm water drains, retaining walls etc.

Completion certificates should be certified by an officer not below the rank of Superintending Engineer/Executive Engineer from Govt. Departments/ Chief Project manager or Equivalent.

5.6 Should have had average financial turnover of Rs 3.00 crore on construction work during the last three consecutive financial years ending 31st March 2010.

5.7 Should not have incurred any loss in more than two year during the last five year ending 31st March 2010.

5.8 Should have solvency of Rs 2.50 Crore certified by a Scheduled Bank and obtained not earlier than three months before the date of submission of Bid.

6 Tenders, should always be placed in sealed envelope, superscripting the name of work and due date. Tenders will be received in the office of the Project Engineer cum Estate Officer, Indian Institute of Science Education and Research, 900, NCL Innovation Park, Dr. Homi Bhabha Road, Pune 411008, up to 15.00 hours on 25/04/2011 and will be opened by him or his authorized representative in his office on the same day at 15.30 hours in presence of the tenderers or their representative who may be present at the stipulate time & venue of tender opening.

7 The tender(s) shall be accompanied by the requisite earnest money in the form of demand draft / pay order or deposit at call receipt of a schedule bank issued in favour Director, Indian Institute of Science Education and Research Pune payable at Pune.

8 The time allowed for carrying out the work shall be 5 (Five) months reckoned from the 15th day after the date of written orders to commence the work.

9 The tenderer(s) shall submit tenders in two sealed covers. The first cover shall contain the earnest money deposit in the manner as indicated and the second cover should contain the

tender document. In case 1st cover is not annexed or earnest money is not in proper form, the tenders shall be out rightly rejected.

- 10 Tenderers are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil conditions access to site and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site once the tender is submitted. No extra charges consequent upon any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The tenderer shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost, all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access facilities for to the workers and all other service required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a tender by a tenderer implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant etc will be issued to him and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.
- 11 The competent authority on behalf of, Indian Institute of Science Education and Research Pune, does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender, and reserves the right to reject any or all of the tenders received without assigning any reasons. Tenders in which any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or any conditions including that of the conditional rebate put forth by the tenderer shall be summarily rejected.
- 12 Canvassing in any form whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.
- 13 The competent authority (IISER-Pune) reserves the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the tenderer shall be bound to execute the same at the rates quoted.
- 14 No engineer of gazetted rank or other gazetted officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of two years after his retirement from Government service, without the previous permission of the Government of India in writing .The contract is liable to be canceled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found at any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the contractors service.
- 15 The bids submitted shall remain valid for acceptance for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of the bid. If any bidder withdraws his tender before the said period or issue of letter of acceptance, whichever is earlier, or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the IISER, Pune, then the IISER, Pune shall, without prejudice to any other

right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the said earnest money as aforesaid. Further the bidder shall not be allowed to participate in the re-tendering process of the work.

16. If all Bidders have submitted unconditional Bids together with requisite Bid security, then all Bidders will be so informed then and there. If any Bid does not contain Bid security in the manner prescribed in the Bid documents, then that Bid will be rejected and the Bidder informed accordingly & The bid will be returned to him without opening. All other valid Bids shall be considered for further process.
- 17 The Bidder's name, the Bid prices, any discounts and such other details as the IISER, Pune may consider appropriate, will be announced by the IISER, Pune at the time of opening.
- 18 In view of postal and other delays, it is suggested that your tender be posted sufficiently in advance of the last date fixed for receipt of tenders or sent through a special messenger, if necessary. Tender received late will not be considered. Telegraphic communications like fax, emails, soft copies etc. received in connection with this tender will also be not considered
