average annual turnover in the last 3 years. But, as per the pg. no. 13 of the Bid Document, clause "Disclaimer", pt. no. 15, it states that in case of multiple L1 bidders, the buyer shall award the contract through Random Algorithm executed by the GeM system. Hence, it is seen that there is contradiction amongst the clauses.

We feel that the earlier stipulation of awarding the contract to the bidder with highest average annual turnover in the last 3 years is the right way taking into account the huge scope of tender. Any bidder with highest turnover will prove to be beneficial in terms of the financial soundness of his

smoothly.

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Hence, we sincerely request the Authority to kindly award the contract to the bidder with the highest average annual turnover in the last 3 years in case of multiple bidders emerging as L1 and make necessary changes in the bid document.

Organization and his ability to carry out the operations

In case of multiple bidder emerging as Lowest I (L 1), the contract shall be then awarded to the Bidder amongst L1 with highest average annual turnover of last three

#### Following clause is incorporated in GeM bid.

In case of multiple L1 bidders against this bid, Institute will use 'Run L1 selection' feature wherein the system would randomly identify a L1 seller. It works on pseudorandom number generator algorithms which is the system generator based on linear congruential algorithm.

Please clarify that when the bidder was quoting the rate, the system was allowed to quote a lump sum rate.

Bidder should quote in commercial bid as per GeM methodology /mandate. However, bidder(s) should note that they cannot quote the service charges less than 3.85% (i.e. Rs. 37,53,750.00 per year) of the estimated cost (i.e. Rs. 9,75,00,000.00 per year) failing which their bid will be considered unresponsive and rejected.

#### OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Proposal on Minimum Floor price for minimum wage based Manpower Outsourcing Service.

The undersigned is directed to refer to Government e-Marketplace (GeM) OM No. 9/JS&ACEO/2022 dated 22.12.2022 regarding the subject cited above and to say as under:

- a. The minimum service charges in the procurement of Manpower Outsourcing Service may be fixed as 3.85% (3% profit plus transaction charges, which are 0.85% at present) as proposed by GeM.
- b. The procuring entities can also fix the service charge above 3.85% with proper justification on file, wherever required. However, such charges should not exceed 7% (including transaction charges) in any case.
- c. Least Cost System (LCS) may be considered for procurement, wherever appropriate, especially in high value cases.
