## **SPECIFIC TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE TENDER**

1) The existing student strength is approximately 1800+, including undergraduates, res earch students and approximate 400 faculties and staff members. The Institute **does not guarantee a minimum number of diners and volume of business at any point in ti me.** 

The number of diners may go down drastically during the term break, summer break, holidays, and outside project assignments of the students. The undergraduate students

have their academic break in the months of May, June, July and December (may vary a little as per the schedule).

- 2) IISER Pune retains the sole discretion to operate multiple canteens concurrently within its campus. The selected contractor is therefore encouraged to provide Affordable Options, ma intain food quality, taste and hygiene to attract and retain diners.
  - 3) The successful bidder of this tender, during the concurrency of the contra ct shall not be allowed to participate in the subsequent tenders for Providing Catering & Allied Services on contractual basis at IISER Pune.
  - 4) The contract shall be given to a successful agency/firm/company for a maximum of 05 years. However, the Institute shall at any time be entitled to determine and termi nate the contract for any reason, including unsatisfactory performance. A notice in writing from the institute to the contractor shall be issued, giving 30 (Thirty) days' ti me for such termination and vacation of the premises, without assigning any reason s. Under exceptional circumstances, this 30 (Thirty) days period may be appropriatel y reduced (or) waived off.
  - 5) The successful Agency / Firm / Company will have to deposit a 5% performance sec urity deposit of the contract value in the form of a Performance Bank Guarantee (PB G) of any Nationalized Bank / Scheduled Bank in favour of Director, IISER Pune. This PBG shall cover the entire period of the contract and shall remain valid for a period of 60 days beyond the period of the contract.
- 6) **Prices:** The prices shall be fixed for the regular meals as quoted and awarded in the Finan cial Bid as per the menu structure in "Annexure F". The agency/firm/company must offer the meals in the given quantity at the approved prices, prepared with the given list of bran ds as specified in the bid document. The prices mentioned shall remain fixed for one year fr om the date of award of the contract. The rates stated are inclusive of GST.

Additional meal serving options shall be implemented based on mutually agreed rat es by the Dining Committee and the Contractor with approval from the competent a uthority of the Institute.

The revision in the price after every one year shall be maximum 5% based on the price day before implementation of revision subject to prior approval of the Competent Authority. Revision shall be implemented from the  $1^{st}$  day of the calendar month.

7) Further, the contracting agency/firm/company shall not be allowed to transfer, assig n, pledge or sub-contract its rights and liabilities under this contract to any other ag ency. The contracting agency/firm/company shall need to provide the services continuously as per the award of the contract. In case of discontinuation of services by the contractor in the middle of the period or non-satisfactory services, breach of any terms and conditions of the contract, non-compliance of the orders of competent aut

hority, etc. the contractor shall be liable for termination of the contract andor neces sary legal action. The contracting agency/firm/company shall also be liable for forfeit ure of their performance security deposit in such a case.

- 8) The contracting agency/firm/company shall get suitable directions from the Designa ted Officials / Dining Committee of IISER Pune and promptly provide the services as required.
- 9) The contracting agency/firm/company shall abide by the rules and regulations of IIS ER Pune and Govt. of India particularly applicable to the said business
- 10) The contracting agency/firm/company and the user shall make every effort to resolv e any dispute or disagreement amicably by direct negotiations.

However, in case of any unresolved issues/disagreements/disputes in connection with the contract, the same shall be settled under the Court of Law within its jurisdiction at Pune. The resultant contract will be interpreted under Indian Laws

- 11) The staff deployed by the contractor shall be medically fit and free from any communica ble disease at all times. Medically unfit employees should not be allowed to work. Periodic (once in six months) medical checkup of all employees should be carried out by the contractor. The certificates shall be verified by the Institute Medical Officer.
- 12) The contractor shall submit to the Designated Official a list of workers, with complete det ails including local/permanent addresses, contact details, and their photographs etc who may be allowed to work in the dining area. Workers credentials shall be verified by the Contractor before their deployment on the Institute site. **Police Verification certificate of the Contractor is to be submitted before commencement of the agreement.**
- 13) If and whenever any of the contractor's employees shall, in the opinion of the Institute, be equilty of any misconduct or be incompetent or negligent in the performance of their duties or that in the opinion of the Institute, it is undesirable for administrative or any oth er reason for such person or persons to be employed in the work, the contractor if, so directed by the Competent Authority, shall remove such person/persons from Institute site within a reasonable time (not more than 10 calendar days). Any person or persons so removed from work shall not again be employed in connection with the work without the written permission of the Competent Authority.
  - 14) The successful Agency / Firm / Company shall provide two sets of uniforms and shoe s to the staff deployed at IISER Pune and replace it as and when required.
  - 15) IISER Pune shall not be responsible for any damages, losses, theft, claims, financial or other injury to any workers deployed by the contractor in the course of their performing the functions/ duties or for payment towards any compensation The contractor has to cover them under a suitable Insurance policy or as required under the applicable laws / Acts.
  - 16) The workers deployed by the contractor shall not claim nor shall be entitled to pay,

perks and other facilities from IISER Pune admissible to casual, ad-hoc, regular/ confirmed employees during or after the expiry of the contract period.

- 17) In case of termination of the contract on its expiry or otherwise, the workers engage d by the contractor shall not be entitled to and shall have no claim for any absorption n nor for any relaxation for absorption in the regular / otherwise capacity in IISER PU NE and they shall be removed by the contractor from the Institute site.
- 18) The contractor shall be responsible for compliance of all statutory provisions relatin g to the business carried out at the Institute site including Minimum Wages Act and compliances under ESIC and PF etc. in respect of the workers engaged by it at IISER PUNE.

- 20) The Income Tax (T.D.S.) shall be deducted at the prevailing rate from any bills towar ds services offered directly to the Institute, as amended from time to time in accordance with the provisions of Income Tax Act, and a certificate to this effect shall be provided to the agency by IISER PUNE.
- 21) In case, the contractor fails to comply with any statutory / taxation liability under ap propriate law, and as a result thereof, IISER PUNE is put to any loss/obligation, monit ory or otherwise, IISER PUNE shall be entitled to get itself reimbursed out of the outstanding bills or the Performance Bank Guarantee of the agency, to the extent of the loss or obligation in monitory terms. The excess amount if any shall be then furth er recovered from the contractor.
- 22) Any damages to the infrastructure facilities/ Property of the Institute caused by the personnel of the agency/ firm/ company; contractor shall bear the responsibility of lo sses and shall replace the same on its own expenses / reimburse the full cost of the same.
- 23) If the designated key employee of the Contractor wants to proceed on leave, they shall inform well in advance to the Section Officer of Dining Services at IISER PUNE, a nd immediate alternative proper arrangements shall be made by the Contractor.
- 24) Minimal accommodation (unfurnished) on campus for the contractor's staff shall be provided by the Institute.
- 25) In case of multiple L1 bidders against this bid, the Institute will use the 'Run L1 sele ction', which is GeM portal feature wherein the system randomly identifies an L1 sell er. It works on pseudorandom number generator algorithms, which is the system ge

nerator based on linear congruential algorithm

- 26) Periodic pest control services shall be provided by the Institute for the kitchen and d ining areas.
- 27) The designated Dining Committee of the Institute will supervise the catering operati ons including but not limited to surprise visits/checks. The Student members of the Committee shall decide on the weekly menu in coordination with the contractor's re presentative well in advance and communicate the same to the Contractor.
- 28) The Director, IISER PUNE, reserves the right to withdrawrelax any of the terms and conditions mentioned above so as to overcome any problem encountered by the contracting parties.
