1	Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC): As per statutory rules, ESIC is applicable on wages up to a ceiling of ₹21,000/- per month. Employees drawing salaries above this threshold are exempt from ESIC or their contributions are restricted to ₹21,000/ We request your approval on whether, for such employees, we may obtain a Workmen's Compensation (WC) policy or appropriate medical insurance in lieu of ESIC, and whether the cost of such insurance would be reimbursable.	Refer GeM bid document, Page No.4, Scope of Work For the Service, Clause no. V. Personnel Management & Statutory Compliance, Point: Additional Insurance is amended to:  The contractor has to obtain Workmen's Compensation (WC) policy, Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana and Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana; Proof of such insurance coverage must be submitted to the Institute, and the cost of such insurance would be reimbursable.
2	Uniform Reimbursement:  Kindly confirm whether the cost of uniforms, if required to be supplied by the contractor, will be reimbursed.	Refer GeM bid document, Page No.4, Scope of Work for the Service, Clause no. V. Personnel Management & Statutory Compliance  Uniforms & Equipment: Providing two pairs of IISER Pune Authorities-approved, all-weather uniforms (Brand: Raymond/SKUMAR/Reputed brand), and one set of rainwear and shoes annually, free of cost to each deployed employee. The contractor is responsible for replacing torn uniforms free of charge based on wear and tear. Wearing the approved uniform during duty hours is compulsory.  It is clarified that no reimbursement for uniforms will be provided.

3	Deployment of Manpower: Please clarify whether we are required to retain the existing manpower currently engaged under the ongoing contract or if we are permitted to deploy new staff.	Refer GeM bid document, Page No.4,  UNDERTAKING FOR RETENTION OF EXISTING RESOURCES
		It is clarified that the Institute will retain existing resources under the new contract.
4	Second Allowance Clarification: The tender document clearly mentions the first allowance components, such as HRA and liveries. However, the second allowance has not been specified. Kindly provide details or clarification regarding this component	Refer GeM bid document, Page No.7 and 8, Security Supervisor  Second allowance is an allowance given to the staff working in a supervisory capacity.
5	Experience: Same and similar nature of work in the last 3 years, having a single work order of 40 security personnel in any government department for a minimum contract period of 1 year  As per the MSME guidelines, those who are registered under the MSME are exempt from providing an experience certification.  Is it exempt for those companies that have registration under MSME?	Refer GeM bid document, Page No.3, Clause No.1  If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per the latest orders issued by the Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be exempted from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above, subject to meeting the quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking exemption from the Experience Criteria shall upload the supporting documents to prove their eligibility for exemption
6	Earnest Money Deposit  Clarification regarding the EMD (Earnest Money Deposit) exemption clause mentioned in the GeM General Terms and Conditions (GTC) Version 4.0 (Version 1.15), dated 11th June 2024.  As per Page 17, Point (m)-v of the GTC: "Sellers/Service Providers having an annual turnover of INR 500 Crore or more, in at least one of the past three completed financial years, are exempted from furnishing Bid Security/EMD."	Yes, Bidders with an annual turnover of ₹500 Crore or more in at least one of the past three completed financial years are exempt from submitting an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD).  Furthermore, MSME-registered firms/agencies are also eligible for EMD exemption. The bidder seeking EMD exemption must submit valid supporting documents for the relevant category as per the GeM GTC with their bid.

7	Clarification on ESIC Applicability  The tender specifies a salary of ₹21,000 for skilled employees. As per ESIC norms, if an employee's gross salary exceeds ₹21,000, ESIC coverage is not applicable. In such a case, kindly clarify what alternate compliance is expected. Are we required to provide Group Mediclaim / Accident Insurance in lieu of ESIC? Please confirm the required approach.	Please refer response to above at Sr. No.1
8	Proof of Attendance for Pre-Bid Meeting  Requesting proof of attendance for pre-bid meeting will be issued. Will an attendance sheet, Minutes of Meeting (MoM), or email confirmation be shared with participating bidders?	Proof of Attendance for Pre-Bid Meeting  The Institute will upload the Minutes of Meeting (MoM) on the GeM portal and the Institute's website. A link to these minutes will also be circulated to the pre-bid participants. This MoM will serve as the official record of attendance and discussions.
9	GeM bid document Clause No. 2 of the Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC), which states:  "Bidder must have a registered office in the Pune/PCMC area for the last three years as on 31.03.2025."  bidder stated that, the comply with all the eligibility conditions mentioned under the Pre-Qualification Criteria (PQC), this specific clause imposes a significant limitation. Many experienced and capable agencies in the security services sector—including those currently having a registered office in Pune—are unable to meet this condition due to not having maintained such an office for	Refer GeM bid document, Page No.10, Eligibility Criteria  Bidder must have a registered office in the Pune/PCMC area for the last three years as on 31.03.2025."  This clause ensures the selected security agency possesses proven local operational capability and stability within the Pune/PCMC area. An established presence for three years guarantees rapid response times in emergencies and efficient deployment of personnel. It also indicates in-depth familiarity with local conditions, labour laws, and effective liaison with regional authorities, which is crucial for robust security management. This requirement minimizes logistical challenges

the entire stipulated duration of the past three years.

bidder requesting that this clause may unintentionally restrict fair competition by disqualifying credible agencies with strong experience and proven track records in similar projects, solely due to the duration of their office's registration in a particular area.

In light of the above, kindly request you to reconsider and either revoke or amend Clause No. 2 of the ATC, in order to allow broader participation and foster a fair and competitive bidding environment.
