4. The qualification prescribed should have been obtained from recognized Universities / Institutions.
5. Age relaxation commensurate with educational qualification and experience of the applicant may be considered for candidates having qualification and experience higher than the advertised with the prior approval of the competent authority
6. The prescribed educational qualification is the bare minimum and mere possession of same does not entitle candidates to be considered in each stage of the selection process.
